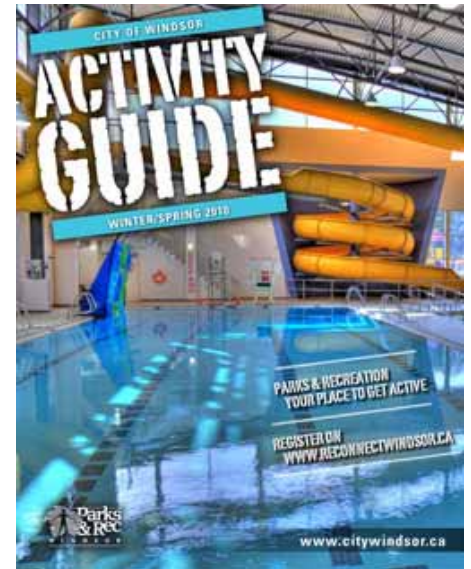

Pathway to Potential

If you are receiving National Child Benefit Supplement, and your children are 17 years of age and under, you may be eligible for the Pathway to Potential subsidy and they can participate in Parks and Recreation programs for only 10% of the cost of the program or pass.

Children are eligible for 2 programs per session. We have four sessions that you can choose from - Winter, Spring, Summer and Fall.

You must bring in proof of receiving NCBS at the time of registration in order to receive the 90% discount.

Admittance & Supervision Requirements

Age	Admission Requirements	Supervision Requirement Child/Caregiver	Wrist Band Colour
5 yrs & under	Always accompanied *	2:1	Pink
6-7 yrs	Always accompanied*	3:1	Orange
Child may obtain a GREEN wristband (in addition to orange) to swim alone. To obtain a GREEN wristband child must complete the facility swim test. Children can swim alone if they obtain an orange/green wristband. They must still have supervision in the facility.			
8-9 yrs	Accompanied or pass* facility swim test	3:1	Orange

If child passes swim test, the **ORANGE** wristband is removed, allowing child unaccompanied access.

* Accompanied: Must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or designate (caregiver) who is at least 14 years of age and is responsible for the direct supervision. Caregiver **MUST** be in bathing attire and within arm's reach of the child(ren) at all times, both in and out of the water. If child(ren) are 8-9 years of age and pass a swim test, they do not need to be accompanied.

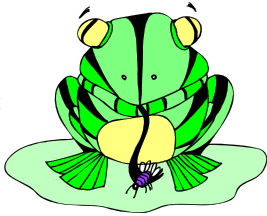
